## **Matters arising from the Minutes**

1. Parish Centre: Maintenance and management issues have been discussed by the Diocesan Commercial Company and Father David following complaints about the standards of cleanliness in the Centre. Various ways forward are being proposed and will be discussed further at a meeting between the Commercial Company and the Finance and Premises Committee.

**Follow-up to Parish Meeting in September:** The main items mentioned (attached to these minutes as a separate document) are being addressed but progress will continued to be monitored. The next Parish meeting will be held in March.

**Feed-back from the Christmas liturgy arrangements:** Vigil Masses and Midnight Mass were well attended. Morning Masses were average. Perhaps we need to give attention next year to more effective publicity. The number of children at the Christmas masses was thought to be disappointing.

**Web-site up-date:** No further information at the moment although attention is being given to updating current web-content.

**Storage in St Alban's Parish Centre:** Problems regarding storage area used by "Messy Church" organisers need to be addressed.

**Cambodia Links:** Query regarding possibility of a trip to the Cambodia community. This has been raised with Father David previously. Costs would not necessarily be prohibitive and such a trip could include visits to local areas of interest, and opportunities to meet with the local community socialising and sharing liturgies. This suggestion will be explored further.

**Blue envelopes/Standing Orders**: Some people who make their parish donations via standing orders feel somewhat embarrassed when they pass the collection plate without putting anything in. Probably we have to accept that everyone is free to donate in their own way and that no-one should be looking over their shoulder at anyone else.
