First Reading: From Prophet Isaiah. 9:1b-4.

In Galilee of the nations the people have seen great light

In the former time the Lord brought into contempt the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, but in the latter time he has made glorious the way of the sea, the land beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the nations. The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who dwelt in a land of deep darkness, on them has light shone. You have multiplied the nation; you have increased its joy; they rejoice before you as with joy at the harvest, as they are glad when they divide the spoil. For the yoke of his burden, and the staff for his shoulder, the rod of his oppressor, you have broken as on the day of Midian.

Response to the Psalm: The Lord is my light and my salvation.

Second Reading First Letter of St Paul to the Corinthians. 1:10-13, 17

I appeal to you that all of you agree, and that there be no divisions among you.

I appeal to you, brothers and sisters, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be united in the same mind and the same judgement. For it has been reported to me by Chloe's people that there is quarrelling among you, my brothers and sisters. What I mean is that each of you says, 'I follow Paul', or 'I follow Apollos', or 'I follow Cephas', or 'I follow Christ, ' is Christ divided? Or were you baptised in the name of Paul? For Christ did not send me to baptise but to preach the gospel, and not with words of eloquent wisdom, lest the cross of Christ be emptied of its power.
